Biographical Note

John [Jack] Anderson Rowan was born February 22, 1923. He entered the Army in June 1943. Rowan served in the Pacific theater in New Guinea from May to July of 1944, then returned and served stateside until he was discharged on October 1945.

After the war, Rowan reenlisted in the Reserve Corps in early 1946 and served overseas in Korea with the 81st Ordnance Tank Maintenance Company as a consultant to a small arms shop. He also served in Japan and China before coming home in October 1946.

In November 1946 he reenlisted in the Reserve Corp, then in 1950 the New Jersey National Guard.

John Rowan died on January 25, 2014 at the age of 92.

Scope and Content of the Collection

The John Rowan Collection contains materials related to Rowan's service in World War II, post war Korea, and the Korean War. This collection includes letters and military documents, as well as artifacts and photographs.

Arrangement

The John Rowan Collection arrived in no discernable order. PMML staff has imposed order into two series:

Series One: Letters, 1919-1958, u.d.

Series one includes letters written during John A. Rowan's time during his service in the military. Most correspondence are between John Rowan and his parents during World War II and post war service in Korea.

Series Two: Military Documents, 1942-1993, u.d.

Series two includes materials from John A. Rowan's time served as in World War II, post war in Korea, and the Korean War. It includes military orders, journals, Rowan's personal military documents, training documents, newsletters, and discharge papers.
